DANNY PYLE served on the Torbay Festival Committee from the beginning, first as secretary, then as President. Danny was a consummate composer of humorous poems and loved the light-hearted touch within poetry. He would have been delighted to have a competition dedicated to making people laugh.

Write a humorous poem in any recognised format, no more than 30 lines.

PRIZES:

- 1st Prize - £100
- 2nd Prize - £50

Prizewinning poems will be announced at the a special Prizegiving event at the Torbay Poetry Festival Sunday 20th October 2019.

Entry Fee: £5.00 for two poems
£10 for five poems.

JUDGE: Brenda Hutchings

BRENDA HUTCHINGS is a poet, painter, actor and a well-respected spoken word artiste. Like Danny, humour is ever present in much of her work.

RULES

1. Poems must be original, unpublished and not accepted for publication. They should be written in English and not exceed 30 lines.
2. Each poem must be typed, single-spaced on one side of A4 paper which must not bear the name of the author or any form of identification. The titles of poems and name and address of the poet should be clearly listed on the entry form or a separate sheet of paper.
3. The entry fee is £5.00 for 2 poems, or 5 poems for £10.00.
4. Receipt of entry will be acknowledged if a stamped, addressed postcard marked 'Receipt' is enclosed with entry.
5. A list of winners will be sent if a stamped addressed envelope marked 'Prizewinners' is enclosed with the entry.
6. Copyright will remain with the author, but the organisers reserve the right to publish any of the winning or commended poems up to one year after the end of the competition.
7. The awards will be announced at the Torbay Poetry Festival. The winning poets will be notified in advance and invited to attend the Prizegiving Party. All short-listed poets will be invited to read their short-listed entry.
8. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the results. The poems will not be returned.
9. The organisers reserve the right to return poems and entry fees if the need arises.
10. Neither the judge nor organisers are eligible to enter the competition.
11. The judge will read ALL the entries.
